

FEES

Under the new regime there has been significant departure from previous fee structure. Fixed fees must equate; consistency and transparency and are payable by stage rather than per activity/ action. Any departure from the prescribed process is open to legal challenge.

FEES - NON HIGH COURT

FEES PAYABLE BY DEBTOR

Once triggered a fee is due and payable due even if all possible activity under that stage not completed, permissible disbursements limited to; Storage fees following removal, Locksmith charges, Court fee on application log, Auctioneers fees, Exceptional costs-following application to court with no other fees or costs being permitted.

AUCTIONEERS FEES

Where goods sold by public auction, the Enforcement Officer/Agent may recover the costs related to the auction:
